




REGULATORY BASES 3RD EDITION OF THE MAGTEL FOUNDATION AWARDS

PREAMBLE

The Magtel Foundation was created as the maximum expression of its Board of Trustees' commitment to social responsibility and the sustainable development of society. In the exercise of its principles and values, the Magtel Foundation wants to recognize, encourage and promote those initiatives and actions that result in people's quality of life through the incorporation of innovative elements that favour social inclusion and contribute to the construction of a more egalitarian society.

For this reason, Fundación Magtel considers its real and effective contribution to the sustainable development of our social, environmental and technological environment to be essential. Within the framework of its activity and in accordance with its founding statutes, meeting its Board of Trustees:

AGREES

That Magtel Foundation wants to recognize the work carried out at a national level in the areas of action, study and development, included in article 7.1 of its Statutes, through the creation and economic endowment of eight Awards for Excellence, under the name "Magtel Foundation Awards" and that will be governed by the following bases.

BASES

1. OBJECT

The 3rd Edition of the Magtel Foundation Awards is convened around four main categories:

- > Social Innovation
- > Technological/Environmental Innovation
- > Social and Labour Integration
- > International Cooperation

Its objective is to highlight in a committed and responsible manner those initiatives that have a positive impact on society in terms of equality and social cooperation, sustainability and technological development.

2. ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

The Magtel Foundation Awards are regulated in accordance with the main standards that guarantee the

impartiality of the competition.

As a novelty in this 2022 call, the total number of prizes to be awarded will be eight, two prizes per category distributed between four first prizes and four second prizes.

The evaluation of the projects presented to any of the established categories will be carried out based on the following selection criteria:

- I. Social impact** of the project
- II. Innovation** that the project entails
- III. Viability and sustainability**, both technical and economic/organizational
- IV. Effectiveness and efficiency** of the results obtained/expected
- V. Associated legal aspects:** Those projects about which there are doubts regarding their legal framework will be excluded

The projects presented must fall into one of the following categories:

2.A) CATEGORY: SOCIAL INNOVATION

Those initiatives that, through the use of new technologies, promote the improvement of quality of life of groups of people in a situation or risk of social exclusion, thus promoting an inclusive society, will be rewarded.

Projects initiated as of January 1, 2022 will be accepted, and they may be completed or in progress at the closing date of the call (October 18, 2022).

Winners: first prize of €3,000, and second prize of €1,000.

2.B) CATEGORY: TECHNOLOGICAL/ENVIRONMENTAL INNOVATION

Two initiatives that propose a technological development or innovation framed in the fields of renewable energy, telecommunications or environment will be awarded.

Without excluding any project, those related to the following topics will be especially valued:

- > Energy storage for self-consumption or for renewable generation plants
- > Solar technology: Thermosolar, photovoltaic, or hybridization
- > Environment: Purification and/or desalination
- > Industry 4.0: Digitization of industrial processes

Projects initiated as of January 1, 2022 will be accepted, and they may be completed or in progress at the closing date of the call (October 18, 2022).

Under detailed justification, and exceptionally for this category, ideas or projects not started at the closing date of the call may be accepted.

Winners: first prize of €3,000, and second prize of €1,000.

2.C) CATEGORY: SOCIAL AND LABOUR INTEGRATION

Two initiatives will be awarded that undoubtedly develop actions to promote the social and labour inclusion of groups in a situation or at risk of social exclusion (vulnerability), as well as they promote social cohesion thanks to these initiatives.

Projects initiated as of January 1, 2022 will be accepted, and they may be completed or in progress at the closing date of the call (October 18, 2022).

Winners: first prize of €3,000, and second prize of €1,000.

2.D) CATEGORY: INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT COOPERATION

Prizes will be awarded to those two projects that carry out actions aimed at achieving one of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), either individually or interrelated with each other, developing interventions that contribute to development processes in impoverished countries, interventions for the promotion of peace, defense of human rights, and democratic values.

Projects initiated as of January 1, 2022 will be accepted, and they may be completed or in progress at the closing date of the call (October 18, 2022).

Winners: first prize of €3,000, and second prize of €1,000.

3. SCOPE

The awards are convened nationally and internationally, and individuals, non-profit entities, private entities, and other organizations with a legal nature may attend.

The projects must be submitted, preferably, in Spanish. English is also accepted.

In general, projects that are in progress or completed according to the dates indicated in each category will be eligible.

Exceptionally, in the category of “Technological/Environmental Innovation” projects that are not started on the date of submission of the application will be admitted, under stated justification of the causes that motivate it.

4. ENDOWEMENT

The prizes have financial endowment. Each category will be awarded with two prizes: first prize of 3,000 euros, and a second prize of 1,000 euros, as well as a commemorative distinction to be delivered in a public ceremony. The amount will be provided as a donation to the winning candidates.

Given that in the Technological/Environmental Innovation category, projects that have not started on the date of submission of the application may be admitted, the candidate entity or person undertakes to allocate the prize to the execution of the aforementioned project, and the Magtel Foundation will reserve the right to request justification of the destination of the endowment during the 3 years after its delivery.

5. SUBMISSION AND DELIVERY TIME

The period for submitting applications will remain open from June 23, 2022 to October 18, 2022, both inclusive.

The submission of applications will be telematic through the forms provided for each category on our website: www.fundacionmagtel.es/premios

Organizations may submit more than one project to each category, and only one award per organization may be obtained.

Each form includes the minimum and mandatory information to be filled in for each application. In addition, and optionally, an annex document may be attached in “.pdf” format with complementary information to the submitted application (maximum 15 MB). **Those applications that do not submit the completed form will be automatically excluded.**

If the application contains rectifiable errors, Magtel Foundation will inform the requesting person/entity so that within a non-extendable period of 5 days from its communication, they can proceed to correct it. In the same way, Magtel Foundation may ask the petitioner for any clarification it deems appropriate in relation to the proposal presented.

The applications to be technically evaluated will be those that fully comply with the bases of the call, including correcting the defects that may be required. **Those applications not corrected within the established period will be excluded from the call.**

6. JURY

The Jury will be made up of five people of recognized prestige in their professional fields, as well as the President of Magtel Foundation. Likewise, the Jury will have a secretary in charge of taking record of the meetings, certifying the agreements, and ensuring compliance with the bases.

The Jury may determine “void prizes”, if so agreed unanimously by its members.

The Jury’s decision will be unappealable, not admitting possible claim, as well as neither appeal nor claim in any of its forms or nature.

7. RESOLUTION

The Jury will meet within 30 days after the deadline for submitting applications.

The winning entities will be informed in advance of the gala, always communicating with the person who submits the application, both by phone and by email. In addition, they must prepare a video summary of their activity and project not superior to two minutes.

The winning entities will be announced at the awards ceremony, published on the website www.fundacionmagtel.es and on the social networks of the Magtel Foundation as of its celebration.

The acceptance of the award entails the obligation to attend the public award ceremony, organized for the last quarter of 2022. In case of refusing attendance, it will be understood as non-acceptance of the award.

8. OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARTICIPANTS

Participation in the prizes implies acceptance, without reservation, of the bases of the call. The participants guarantee the authorship, accuracy and veracity of the data they provide for participation in it.

Likewise, the participants accept the privacy and data protection policy of Magtel Foundation, made available to them in the registration form available on the Awards website.

9. DISSEMINATION

Magtel Foundation may carry out for an unlimited time as many campaigns to publicize the prizes as it deems appropriate.

The participants declare that they know and accept that the non-sensitive information of the projects may be published on the Magtel Foundation website, as well as through other means that the promoters designate and consider appropriate to publicize this initiative. Organizations/ Candidates give their consent for it at the time of the submission of the application.

The participants keep intact the authorship and/or ownership of the projects presented, as well as any industrial and intellectual property rights that may derive from them, without it being understood in any case that the publication and/or dissemination by the promoters implies renunciation, assignment and/or transfer of their industrial and intellectual property rights.

10. SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION OF THE PRIZE

Failure by the winners to comply with the obligations expressed in section eight of this call, that would make the correct resolution of the financial aid unfeasible, will allow the aid to be revoked following a reasoned report from the members of the Commission, and with prior to the hearing process of the interested party.

In case of detection of error, omission, plagiarism, or falsity of the award-winning candidacy after the publication of the jury's decision, Magtel Foundation reserves the right to claim the economic endowment delivered to the person/entity awarded, as a guarantee and safeguard of its prestige as organization as well as to undertake the appropriate legal actions.

11. PAYMENT OF FINANCIAL AID

The prizes will be delivered via bank transfer, this being the only admissible legal procedure for acceptance.

Payment is made after the awards ceremony has been held, and once the official announcement of the winners has been published on the Magtel Foundation website.

12. DATA PROTECTION

All of the personal data that could be obtained as a result of the submission of the candidacy, management, development and execution of the awards will be processed, stored in a specific file, for its use by the Magtel Foundation in accordance with the European and Spanish regulations, with applicants/organizations having at all times the right of access, rectification or cancellation, opposition, deletion, limitation of treatment, portability and not being the subject of individualized decisions.

13. ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

Participation in the call implies acceptance of these rules and full compliance with the result derived from its application. Violation of the same will be grounds for disqualification.
